

Municipal Villa and Palazzo Giordano

Leaving the Renaissance portal of the church, you are greeted by *Palazzo Giordano* and its *Villa*, harmonious example of Baroque architecture. An arch leads from the side entrance to the hall, which is characterized by the typical cobblestone pavement. Its ancient garden, which is currently a *Municipal Villa* in Montefusco, offers an awe-inspiring sight of the *Sannio* that reaches up to Matese mountain-tops. From this point of view, you can take a look at the *Dormiente del Sannio*, a striking depiction of a lying woman framed by the Taburno-Camposauro mountain peaks.

Several adjacent halls and frescoed neoclassical-themed ceilings with fictitious architectures and mythological scenes are present on the noble floor of the *Palace*. The paintings can be found under the alcoves in the smaller environments. The *Palace's* charm and refinement are enhanced by the alternation of floral decorations and fantastic landscapes, creating a suggestive atmosphere.
